We, the Sisters of the Congregation of Jesus have, as our inspiration and inheritance, the vision of Mary Ward, who is our Prophetic Foundress (1585 - 1645).

Mary Ward was born on 23rd January, 1585 in Elizabethan England, at the time of the great religious intolerance. As a woman of great faith that she was, she saw the need for a sound religious education for young women who would assume responsibilities in society and in the church, for she said, "women in time to come will do much".

A woman of vision, Mary saw the potential of women and the need for their education. In 1609, she left her homeland with a small group of companions to open a school at St. Omer [now in France] where girls were taught reading, writing and sewing, as well as the principles of Christian life.

From this modest beginning came Mary Ward's world-wide congregation, its two branches known today as the Congregation of Jesus and the Institute of the Blessed Virgin Mary [Loretto Sisters]. This work expanded throughout five continents. In 1853, this mission was started in India, Patna. She had a passionate love for Integrity, Justice and Freedom and she consistently endeavoured to live out these qualities. She died on 30th January, 1645. The inscription on Mary Ward's tombstone sums up the life of a woman who was 'Wholly God's':

To love the poor, persevere in the same, live, die and rise with them was all the aim of Mary Ward who lived 60 years and eight days and died on 30th January, 1645

Years have gone by and, century after century, hundreds and hundreds of women, follow the footsteps of our Foundress Mother Mary Ward.

For over four hundred years, we have been educating the leaders of tomorrow.

Our Foundress Mary Ward, said 'Women in time to come will do much", and her faith in what could be achieved through the education of girls and young women has proved to be well-founded.

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

PREAMBLE

The 'Preamble' of the Constitution of India is a brief introductory statement that sets out the guiding purpose and principles of the document, and it indicates the source from which the document derives its authority — meaning, the people. The hopes and aspirations of the people, as well as the ideals before our nation, are described in the preamble in clear words. It may be considered as the soul of the Constitution. The preamble can be referred to as the preface which highlights the entire Constitution. It was adopted on 26th November, 1949 by the Constituent Assembly and came into effect on 26th January, 1950.

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN, SOCIALIST, SECULAR, DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity; and to promote among them all;

FRATERNITY, assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation; within the country;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY, this Twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do **HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.**

The sisters of the Congregation of Jesus (CJ.) conduct several schools and colleges in India. The Congregation was founded in 1609 by Mary Ward, a valiant English lady for moral and spiritual formation in response to the needs of the times.

Our schools and colleges strive to prepare our students to be responsible, mature and integrated personalities. We aim at developing in our students an awareness of God's love, care and concern, through which they may find meaning in life and hope for the future. We seek to form thoroughly educated persons, who motivated by genuine love and spirit of service, are alive to the needs of our times. Alongwith secular knowledge, we strive to instil in our students, strong personal convictions and right values to motivate their actions. To achieve this we seek to form in them a right conscience in their relations to God and their fellow men with a thirst for truth, a sense of social justice, genuine concern for others and obedience to lawful authority.

ADMINISTRATION

Admissions and withdrawals

- 1. To be admitted into class prep, a girl must have completed four years on 1st March of the current year.
- 2. The final decision with regard to admission rests with the Principal. Recommendations will not be considered and DONATIONS NOT ACCEPTED.
- 3. No Pupil from another school will be admitted without a Transfer Certificate. She is also required to appear for an Entrance test. A pupil coming from another state should have her Transfer Certificate countersigned by the Inspector of Schools.
- 4. The School Authorities reserve the right to refuse admission without assigning any reason.

- 5. The date of birth of a pupil, as recorded in the admission register cannot be changed. Parents are advised to give the correct date of birth of the child, at the time of admission.
- 6. Pupil leaving the School after 31st May, must give a month's notice or three months' fee in lieu thereof.
- 7. Application for a Transfer Certificate shall be made in writing to the Principal by the parent or guardian of the pupil. Rs. 100/- will be charged for the issue of a Transfer Certificate.
- 8. A student who fails in the same class for two years in succession will not be allowed to remain in the school.

CURRICULUM

The school prepares Candidates for the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (Class 10) and the Indian School Certificate Examination (Class 12).

The Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) has been designed to provide an examination, in a course of general education of the Kothari Commission, through the medium of English. The Standard of the Examination presupposes a school course of ten years duration (Class I-X).

The Indian School Certificate Examination (ISC) is based on a two year course of studies after class X. Students passing the ISC Examination are eligible for admission to the first year degree course in any Indian University.

SUBJECTS OF STUDIES

Christian doctrine or Value Education, English Language and Literature, Hindi Language and Literature, Sanskrit (Cl. V to VIII), History & Civics, Geography, Science (Physics, Chemistry and Biology), Mathematics, Economics, Commerce, Accounts, Computer Science, Physical Education, Humanities (History, Pol. Science, Geography), S.U.P.W., Drawing, Physical Training and Singing.

ASSESSMENTS AND PROMOTIONS

Prep to V

Promotion at the end of the Scholastic year will depend on daily assessments. In order to avoid stress and strain at the end of the year, students are urged to work regularly. Education is more than securing a pass percentage of marks at the end of the year. Parents are requested to inculcate in their children habits of self study at home. It is necessary that children revise at home the lessons taught in school.

The daily assessment will include written and oral work announced or unannounced. Hence, parents are requested to send their children to school regularly unless prevented by serious illness in which case a medical certificate should be submitted along with a leave letter within 2 days.

Prep - II will have no Final examinations. Promotion will depend on the year's performance. Class III - XII will have a written final examination. Reports will be issued in July and December.

Class VI to XII will have half yearly examinations too.

A minimum of **40% in the aggregate in English, Hindi, Mathematics and Science** is essential for promotion, besides reaching a satisfactory standard in other subjects. Marks below 40 will not be considered in the final aggregate. Parents should encourage their children to work hard daily in order to avoid undue stress and strain at the end of the year. The only one way to success is **'Doing the right thing at the right time.'**

SCHOOL RULES AND DISCIPLINE

For the special attention of the students

- 1. At the first bell all must fall into line immediately for the Assembly. Pupils are expected to obey their captains, elected by the school.
- 2. In going from one classroom to another for special subjects, all shall move in an orderly manner, under the supervision of the captains.
- 3. Strict regularity and punctuality, implicit obedience, courtesy in words and deeds, cleanliness in dress and person and proper care of books and school property are expected from every pupil.
- 4. Irregular attendance, neglect of home-work, habitual lack of interest in school activities, stealing and misconduct even outside the school premises, wilful, repeated breaches of school regulations are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of the child from the school.
- 5. Pupils are responsible to the School Authorities not only for their conduct in the school but also their general behaviour outside. Any report of objectionable conduct on the part of any pupil will make her liable for disciplinary action. Hence misbehaviour in public places and conveyances is liable to the same action.
- 6. The Principal, in the interest of the school may ask a parent/guardian to withdraw his child/ward should the child's conduct and behaviour in the Principal's opinion, be in any way detrimental to the common good of the school and its smooth running.
- 7. All pupils are required to wear school uniform. Neatness in dress and person should be cultivated by every pupil. Long nails, nail polish, the wearing of finger rings, chains or any kind of jewellery or the bringing of expensive articles to School is strictly prohibited. The school will not be responsible for their loss.
- 8. All should be particularly careful TO THROW PAPER into the waste paper bins specially provided for this purpose.

- 9. In school, all are expected to converse in English. Hindi may be spoken during Hindi lessons only.
- 10. Gifts to members of staff or other demonstrations in their honour, require previous sanction of the Principal. All pupils should endeavour to excel in the practice of good manners and obedience to their Teachers.
- Periodicals, transistors, cameras, MP3/MP4 players, ipods, smart phones and books - other than those prescribed may not be brought to the School premises without the explicit permission of the Principal. Pupils may not exchange Library books without the permission of the Librarian.

12. Mobile phones are strictly forbidden in School.

- 13. After reporting to School, children may not leave the Premises without the permission of the Principal. The school will not be responsible for the protection and safety of the offenders in this respect.
- 14. During recess, pupils should not remain in any of the class rooms. Pupils are expected to attend all School functions and meetings.
- 15. Sports and games are very essential for physical fitness. Every pupil must take part in School games and other activities, unless declared physically unfit by a medical certificate or exempted by the Principal.
- 16. Collection of money for any purpose whatsoever requires the Principal's sanction. No one may sell raffle tickets, stickers etc. without the explicit permission of the Principal. However, children are encouraged to practice humanitarian values by means of 'Sparing and Sharing' and by 'Love offerings'. Such collections to help the unfortunate will be entirely voluntary.
- 17. Pupils are themselves responsible for their own books, tiffin-carriers or any other article they may bring to School.
- 18. No pupil may be absent except for special reason for which leave should be applied for in writing by the parent/guardian in the Leave Record of the diary or E-care panel. Oral messages will not be accepted.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS

- 1. Parents are expected to co-operate with the School Authorities in enforcing regularity and discipline. They should see to it that their children prepare their lessons and take active interest in all the activities of the School.
- 2. Parents are to sign the Progress Reports, or any other information, when so required. Failure to do so will cause great mutual inconvenience.
- 3. Private tutions are not encouraged. Parents/guardians may not make private arrangement for tution with members of the staff, without consulting the Principal. Teachers are not permitted to give private tutions to their own pupils.
- 4. Parents and guardians are specially requested to notify the school of any change in their address and phone numbers.
- 5. When communicating with the Principal, parents are requested to mention in their letter the name, class, section of their child.
- 6. Parents/Guardians or other persons are not permitted to see pupils or teachers during class hours without the sanction of the School Authorities.
- 7. Parents are requested not to send for their children during the class hours, except in case of unforeseen circumstances and in such case, a written application duly signed by the parent must be produced.
- 8. Late comers without a valid reason will not be admitted to class.
- 9. Parents are requested to foster in their children habits of neatness and punctuality.
- 10. Parents are requested to make the necessary arrangements for the return of their children from the school. Students who happen to be left behind in the school after the class hours, should report to the office without delay. The school cannot take responsibility of the students after the class hours.

- 11. It is very much appreciated when persons respond readily to the invitations sent to them to attend the Parent-Teacher meeting and other school events. It is only with the co-operation of the parents that the school can promote the all round development of students.
- 12. Any communication (request, complaint, suggestion) made by the parents to the school should be addressed to the Principal. The matter should be clearly stated and signed.
- 13. Woollen coats, cardigans, tiffin boxes, bags and books must bear the name of the owner.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Physical Training, Drill & Games form an important part of School Activities. Games and sports are organised and played under the supervision of a P.T. Instructor or class teacher. All the pupils are expected to take active part in games. Exemptions may be granted by the Principal on submitting a Medical Certificate as well as a written application from the parent.

Singing, Dancing, Hand work, Drawing and Needle-work are also included in the Time Table. Inter House Debates, Elocution and Dramatics are also encouraged.

THE LEADERSHIP TRAINING SERVICE (L.T.S.)

The School provides opportunity to interested students to develop their leadership qualities (Physical, Mental, intellectual and spiritual). The L.T.S. has its branches all over India, and has its motto "For God and Country". Through weekly meetings, members search out ways and means of serving God and Country better as well as for their own selfimprovement. Discussions, Debates, Skits, singing devotional songs and prayer meetings are some of the features of the weekly meetings. Spare and Share, Each One Teach One, One Good Act a Day and a few minutes of personal prayer are some of the other targets which the L.T.S. tries to inculcate in its members. The members work under the guide appointed by the Principal.

THE UNIVERSAL SOLIDARITY MOVEMENT

The School also provides opportunity to students to become members of the Universal Solidarity Movement (USM). The goal of this movement is to build a civilization of love. It is a programme of national reconstruction through personal transformation of individuals. It promotes patriotism. The specific objectives of the movement are enlightened leadership, responsible citizenship, universal solidarity, ecological consciousness, harmony among religions and ethnic groups, education for social transformation and nation building.

Our world requires enlightened leaders and responsible citizens who care for the welfare of the humanity in the years ahead. This movement prepares the students to achieve this goal and to become agents of peace and builders of a universal family. It also enables them to enlighten their conscience and character and to make them responsible citizens who will work for inter-religious harmony, global solidarity, moral regeneration and nation building.

THE SCHOOL LIBRARY

The school library consists of books suitable for children of all classes. Books are issued weekly to Classes VI-XII.

SPECIAL FEATURES

The School is run on the lines of the House System. Captains are elected at the commencement of the year on the basis of character and allround proficiency. Pupils are expected to obey the House Moderators and Captains appointed by the School Authorities.
